- \* 7 participants enjoy the finger nail art program. This program is regularly schedule for the second Saturday of each month.
- \*3 Food distributions were held this month serving over 40 families.
- \*Movie- "Storks" had 18 participants, mainly ages 6-12.
- \*Movie "Sing" had 25 participants ages 6-12
  - Both movies were show during the spring break for WJUSD.
- \*melted crayon art-3 participants.
- \*Hora de Cuentos: 2 programs during the month with 5 participants the first week and the second one was during our Dia de los Ninos program.
- \*Library bingo-10 card were given out with 2 returned to get prizes.
- \*4 teens were at the Teen Group on April 27, 2017. They made their own grilled cheese sandwiches and learn to make rice Krispy treats in the microwave. The group activity was learning to use wood burning tools in an effort to make Mother's Day gifts. All of the participants were 13-14 years old instead of our usual 16-17 year old group. We went over some of the agreement and explained how the group could be structured.
  - There were lots of leftover makings for grilled cheese so we had an impromptu lunch in the library the next day we were open
- \* Outreach to CCHS every Thursday morning is going well. Staff engages teen parents in rhymes and activities to promote early literacy.
- \*CCHS has agreed to let the library use the lawn area in the front of the school for any summer program that needs to be outside.
