During the month of July 2017 the Yolo Branch Library was open 12 days for a total of 64.5 hours

July programs:

- * Family Place was used every day by children of all ages. They used legos, planks, foam block, games, dinosaurs and puppets.

- * 3 Food distributions were held this month serving over 40 families.
