During the month of November 2017 the Yolo Branch Library was open 12 days for a total of 64 hours.

November programs:

*Let' Create program was held 6 times with at least 6 participants and as many as 14. Each week featured a different activity all with the underlying theme of create something that the participants could either give for the holidays or use as a decoration. The activities would start on Tuesday then built on throughout the week. We had foil embossing, duct tape engineering, making items out of felt, craft sticks, pompoms and wine corks as well as creating bead jewelry.

*Lest We Forget part 2 was held again in Zamora where they had 21 participants. The Zamora book club hosts this event and holds a potluck at the same time.

*As the result of a new grant Yolo received 8 more hotspots that can be checked out by the community.

*This month we have had the privilege of enjoying the volunteer efforts of one of our local teens. She needed to volunteer 20 hours of community service to meet her Church obligation.

*3 Food Bank distributions were held helping over 40 families.

December will once again have the ongoing program of Let's Create.

Thursday December 21, 2017 the Friends will once again host the Holiday present wrapping where the community can come in and wrap gifts using our supplies or bring their own. This year we have had several donations of items that the community can use just in case they are "one gift short"
