Three new library cards were given this month.

January programs:

*The learning to face paint program had 9 participants and was facilitated by Maria Sandoval.

*12 children participated in a sculpting project. They used an air drying modeling clay to create objects were later painted with acrylic paints. They made a cheeseburger, French fries, a hot dog in the bun, tacos, a volcano with lava, a soda can with a straw and several snowmen.
