Staff also helps on Saturdays as needed. Staff and volunteers assist with homework 50 times in January. Winter Read for teens and adults finished on January 31st.

Staff helped him prepare questions for this interview as well as provide an additional resource of help by introducing him to one of our patron who's major was journalism.
