During the month of February, 2016, the Yolo Branch Library was open 9 days, for a total of 48.5 hours.

Statistics for February 2016

- *Family place usage: an average of 8 children enjoyed 22 activities
- *Door count: 357
- *Computer signups: 76
- *Number of times meeting room used: 8
- *Volunteers: 1 adults; 6 total hours
- *Reference questions answered: 58

February programs:

- *Bilingual story time: 2 programs during the month, with an average of 7 children attending each program.
- *Craft after the story time had 5 participants.
- *Nine teens gathered for our Teen Takeover on February 25.
- *Eleven children enjoyed Explore with Meg during February.
- *Twelve patrons attended the movie Goosebumps (and watched the whole movie)
- *Eleven adults and five children enjoyed blind date with a movie.
- *Eight children participated in the Chinese New Year craft.
- *Fifty two people came to the Food bank distribution the third Friday of the month.
