#### August 2018 ACTIVITIES HIGHLIGHT:

**Computer assistance:** Computer assistance is available Tuesdays and Thursdays from 1-3 pm.

**Hora de Cuentos:** Wednesdays at 6:15 pm. There is an average of 6 youth attending each week.

**Let's Create:** Weekly program where participants can come and create art, friendships, exploration and supportive environment.

**Loteria:**

- Each Wednesday at 5:00 young and old gather to play Loteria. One of the members of the community is the caller, kids that are playing help with the Spanish pronunciation and winners choose their prize for each games. Average of 15 participants each week.

**Lunch @ the Library-** Lunch is provided Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursday to anyone under the age of 18. This program is a joint effort between the USDA, United Way, DJUSD, CLA and the Yolo Branch Library. This program ended August 9.

**Tony Borders "Animals around the World"** – Magical ventriloquist Tony Borders provided an educational as well as entertaining program using his great puppets. 25 people of all ages attended.

**Back to School Pizza party** – Pizza from Little Caesar's was provided for 27 kids.

**3 D printing** - teen volunteers help patrons learn about 3-D printing. The Luxbot mini is at the Yolo branch until September 1<sup>st</sup>. The 3-D printer will then travel on to Esparto.

**Car show activities** – the Library hosted 3-D printing and face painting under the tent in front of the Library. Friends of the Davis Library provided funds for Emma Knight to do free balloon twisting for kids. Inside the Library candy sushi and marshmallow engineering had about 50 participants.
