Hora de Cuentos: Wednesdays at 6:15 pm.

Let's Create: Weekly program where participants can come and create art, friendships, exploration and supportive environment.

Food bank: The Library still host the Eat Well Yolo program the first and third Thursday of each month. This event is in partnership with the Food Bank and Empower Yolo.

Tea & Conversation: This group will meet on the 2nd Tuesday of the month and the target audience is adults. We supply the tea and goodies and participants bring their own mug. It is a round table, relaxed and informal conversation group who engage in a wide variety of topics.

Loteria : Loteria is back on the 3rd Wednesday of each month

Legos challenge: 4th Saturday of each month.

Family movie: The 2nd Saturday of the month the library hosts a family movie.

Teen group: group activity for age 13-19.

SRP – August – Jon Lopez Real Magic: 31 people attended this great program featuring all sorts of magic. Jon is from Winters and connects his learning magic to using the library.

Car Show Activities- Face painting, candy sushi and family movies. *Estimate of 150 people came into the Library to enjoy activities and beat the heat.*

3-D printer: The mini 3-d printer was in the branch this month. *The teens were in charge of helping anyone who was interested chose and print an object. Of the 14 days the 3-D printer was available it was in constant use for 12 of those days.*
