### **DONOR BILL OF RIGHTS**

Philanthropy is based on voluntary action for the common good. It is a tradition of giving and sharing that is primary to the quality of life. To ensure that philanthropy merits the respect and trust of the general public, and that donors and prospective donors can have full confidence in the Friends of the Yolo Branch Library of Yolo and projects, events, and causes it supports. The Friends of the Yolo Branch Library of Yolo declares that all donors have these rights:

1. To be informed of the Friends of Yolo Branch Library of Yolo's mission and of the way the Friends of the Yolo Branch Library of Yolo intends to use donated resources.
2. To be assured their gifts will be used for the purposes for which they were given.
3. To receive appropriate acknowledgement and recognition.
4. To be assured that information about their donation is handled with respect and with confidentiality and that all requests to remain anonymous will be honored.
5. To know that their names or any other information will never be shared with other groups for any purpose.
6. To expect that all relationships with individuals representing the Friends of the Yolo Branch Library of Yolo will be professional in nature.
7. To feel free to ask questions when making a donation and to receive prompt, truthful, and forthright answers.
8. To be informed of the identity of those serving on the Friends of the Yolo Branch Library of Yolo's governing board, and to expect the board to exercise prudent judgment in its stewardship responsibilities.
9. To have access to the Friends of the Yolo Branch Library of Yolo's all recent financial statements.
