During the month of September, 2015, the Yolo Branch Library was open nine days, for a total of 49.5 hours.

Statistics for September 2015

- *Family place usage: 72 times by 19 youth
- *Door count: 305
- *Computer signups: 57
- *Number of times meeting room used: 7
- *Volunteers: 2 adults; 10.25 total hours
- *New cards : 2

September programs:

- *Bilingual story time: 2 programs during the month, with 0 children participating.
- *Explore with Meg met 3 times with an average of 8 participants.
- *Six local teens were at the teen gathering on September 24.
- *Puppet theater had nine participants.

Of note:

- *Due to the poor attendance to our story times we have asked for feedback from the community-a new time has been selected and we will start at 4:00 with a craft afterwards.
- *The Yolo Branch had 27 items donated for the honor shelf.
- *6 honor books were taken.
- *A local student came in for homework help in AP English-over a two week period staff helped with 15 questions-she reported that her teacher was very impressed with her understanding of the text-she was very appreciative of the efforts of staff..
- *The 2 new cards were a direct result of the survey about the new library-individuals brought in the survey and asked to get a card.
